- The British Koi Keepers Society accepts koi into their show on behalf of the entrant. Every care and precaution will be taken towards all koi entered however the Society cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage
- The National Show is run in accordance with the Show Rules & Guidelines adopted by the Society at the time of the Show, these can be found on the National Koi Show website
- We appreciate circumstances can change, however if for any reason you cannot attend the Show, you must let us know as soon as possible via showvats@bkks.co.uk If no contact is made, vat booking fees will be forfeited
- All exhibitors koi MUST travel to and from the show double bagged and boxed, in an oxygenenriched atmosphere or in aerated vats or tanks. Please contact us if you need any advice or guidance
- When transporting your fish ensure your boxes are stowed parallel to your vehicles axle(s), this will minimise any damage to the fish should heavy or emergency braking occur
- Fish that are known to have been exposed to KHV or SVC via an outbreak in their home pond are not permitted to be brought onto the showground
- Once Benching is complete, we will ask you to digitally sign our Benching Form
- If there is a problem with a koi or vat, or any other issue as indicated by the Show Chairman or Koi Welfare Officer, this may result in a request for de-benching. You must comply immediately if this request is made
- Any exhibitor exceeding the maximum points for their vat, will be requested to return the additional koi to their home pond (see Show Rules)
- Each exhibitor will be able to inspect their own online water testing data
- Fresh water for filling zippy vats or tanks will be available on the Sunday, see a member of the Show Water Team before 12.00pm
